

Press Release: DeSIRA CONNECT Days in Hanoi, Vietnam

We are pleased to invite you to the DeSIRA CONNECT Days Asia & The Pacific, which will occur from January 14-16 2025, at the Authentic Hotel in Hanoi, Vietnam.

This event is organised by the European Commission through the DeSIRA-LIFT Service Facility and in collaboration with the Vietnam Academy of Agricultural Sciences (VAAS) and the CIRAD Regional Office.

About the Event:

The DeSIRA CONNECT Days gather organizations from Asia and the Pacific focused on research and innovation for sustainable agriculture, alongside a diverse group of stakeholders from the region and beyond, including national and international research organisations, farmer organizations, NGOs, and policy actors. Key partners such as FAO, APAARI, APIRAS, AgriCord, CGIAR and major regional and international networks like TPP, ALISEA, GIAN and PROLINNOVA have already confirmed their participation.

Participants will share and critically reflect on lessons and outcomes from DeSIRA (Development-Smart Innovation through Research in Agriculture) projects and explore pathways for scaling transformative innovations in agrifood systems toward sustainability transitions.

This three-day event is designed to engage participants in a variety of dynamic activities, including presenting their projects and collaboratively reflecting on key topics such as participatory co-innovation with civil society and the private sector, as well as mechanisms for responsible innovation and sustainable impacts on livelihoods. The discussions will explore the role of research in driving agricultural innovation, fostering education, creating jobs, and shaping policy. The focus will be placed on farmer- and community-led innovation and the agroecological transition, with an emphasis on knowledge-based approaches, investment strategies, policy development, and scaling research models that are already producing significant, positive outcomes in the region.

The event is the last in a series of four CONNECT days organised in 2024 in Bogota (Colombia), Kigali (Rwanda) and Accra (Ghana), with the main goal to capture the impact of

the EU-funded DeSIRA initiative run in over 65 countries across three continents between 2019 and 2026. The events highlight the major contributions of R&I in addressing complex issues relating to sustainability transitions and agrifood system transformation, towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goals, in low- and middle-income countries

DeSIRA Connect days provide participants with insights on innovation mechanisms and scenarios for a climate resilient agriculture - healthy for the planet and the people - to build a long-lasting impact on food security, poverty alleviation, and socio-economic and gender-balanced inclusion while protecting biodiversity and ecosystems.

The event will feed the broader agenda of international initiatives, policies and strategies in support of sustainable agriculture and food systems
