Community validation

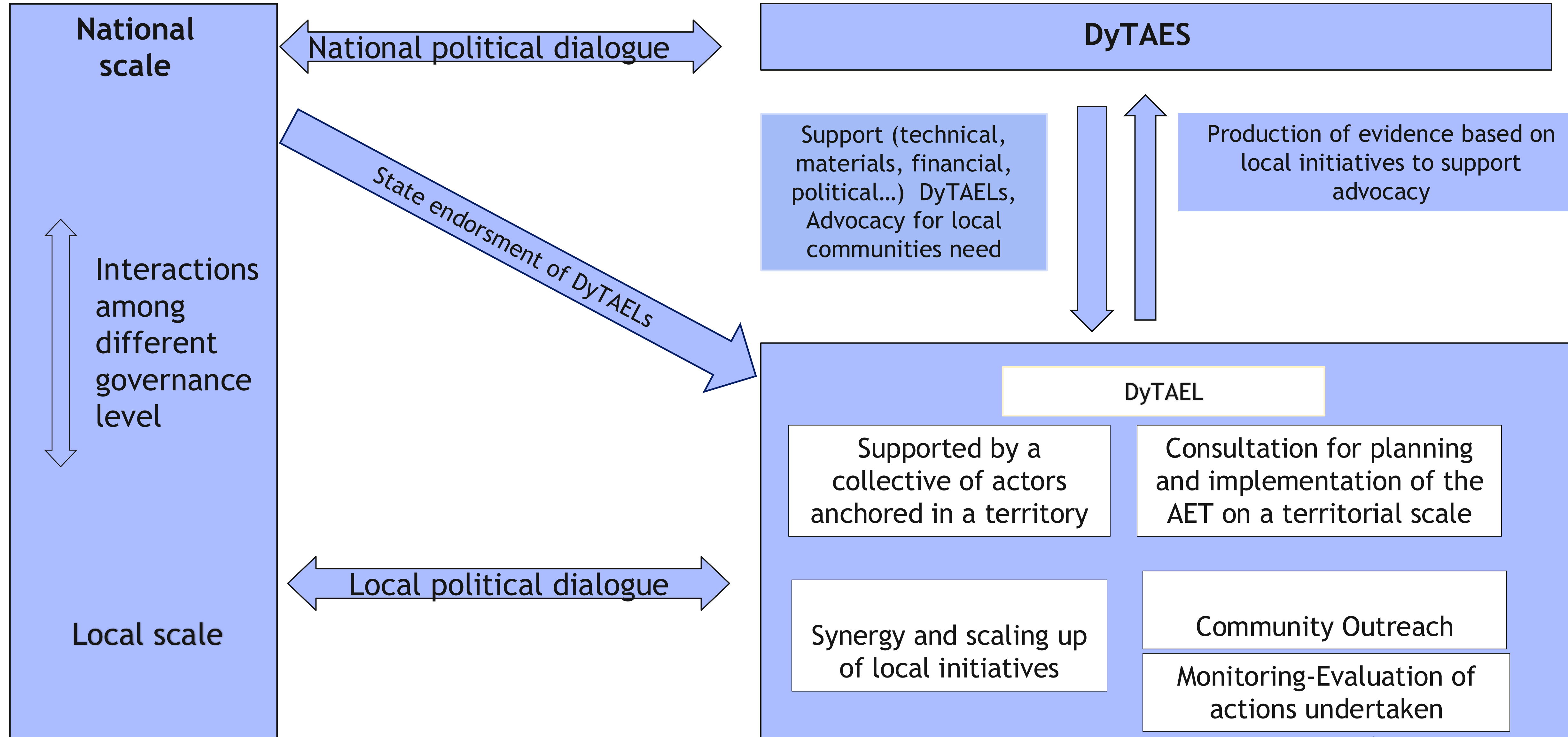

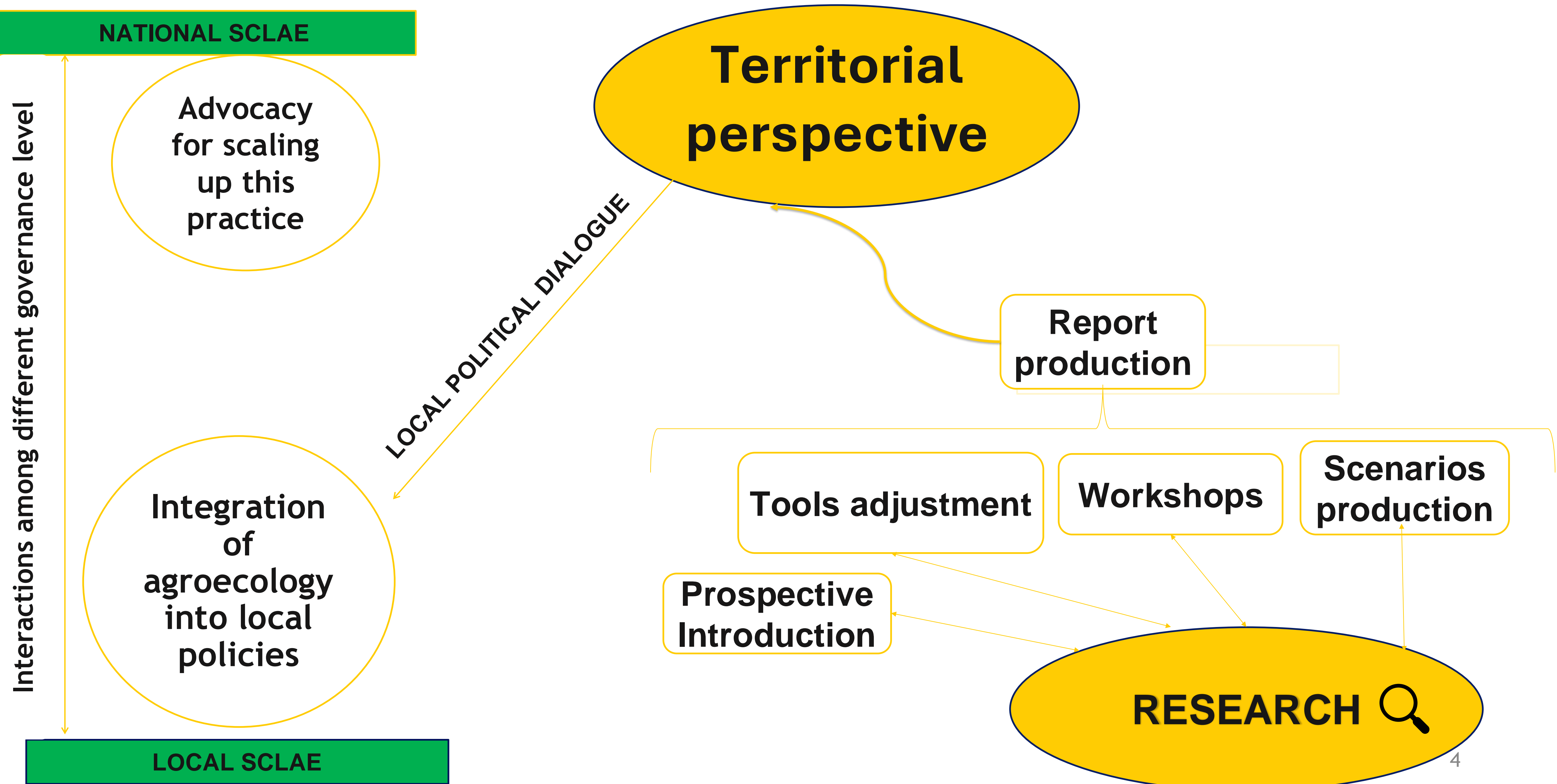
