Consortium Europe-Africa on Research and Innovation for Food Systems Transformation

- Before 2018- RINEA, ProIntensAfrica, PAEPARD etc
- 2018- CSA LEAP4FNSSA
- to provide a **structured mechanism** for aligning research **priorities** and fostering closer collaboration between African and European institutions
- focused on facilitating policy coherence and stakeholder coordination.
- FNSSA Database has been put in place currently holding 625 U-EU FNSSA projects
- Launched the AU-EU International Research Consortium (IRC) (Sept. 2022)

- Aligning policies for sustainable innovation uptake








IRC offering for enabling the Environment for Scaling Innovations

- Infrastructure and logistical constraints
- Inequities in AU-EU R & I partnerships
- Key strategies
- Multi-Stakeholder Collaboration Partnerships between researchers, policymakers, private sector, and farmers
- Capacity Building Training programs and knowledge transfer
- Knowledge Exchange Digital platforms and innovation hubs
- Policy and Investment Alignment Supportive policies and financial mechanisms







The IRC support more conducive environments for the scaling and effective policy-design, implementation, reflection and learning through:


- Creation of a transdisciplinary stakeholder dialogue structure
- Secretariat support to the AU-EU High Level Policy Dialogue and its Working Group on FNSSA and associated AU-EU FNSSA partnership governance structures
- Facilitation of communication, gender & youth and a funders' Working Groups, including an innovative funding mechanism
- Proactive identification and facilitation of opportunities for the scaling of innovations and sharing of knowledge between projects, programmes, and food system actors
- Brokerage and clustering between multi-actor groups, including agri-businesses, policymakers, extension and advisory services, academia and researchers



Conclusions (2): Further actions and prospects of the AU-EU FNSSA IRC

Consortium Europe-Africa on Research and Innovation for Food Systems Transformation

- 'Internationalisation' of the AU-EU IRC on FNSSA
 - Enhancing North-South and South-South research collaboration with inclusive approaches that empower women and youth in agriculture – connections with the CGIAR, FAO, UNFS program etc
 - Increased AU-EU funding for joint research projects, whilst ensuring equitable funding and technology transfer – **Member States**
 - Stronger institutional partnerships and policy coherence
- Strategies for the Sustainability of the IRC
 - IRC members mirroring AKIS stakeholders
 - Network of networks approach
 - Ownership by members signaling a positive and serious commitment that should be leveraged
 - Continued alignments of IRC services with needs of Funders & Development partners
